One amongst the only four companies from India to make it to the DJSI World Index

India – September 13, 2017 – S&P Dow Jones Indices (S&P DJI), one of the world's leading index providers, and RobecoSAM, an investment specialist focused exclusively on Sustainability Investing (SI), have announced that Tech Mahindra Ltd. has been included in the Dow Jones Sustainability Indices (DJSI) for the third year in a row. Tech Mahindra, one amongst the only four Indian companies to make it to the DJSI World Index and one of the eleven Indian companies in the DJSI Emerging Markets category, retained its position in the Dow Jones Sustainability Index under both the categories.

Every year, RobecoSAM assesses the world's largest companies via its Corporate Sustainability Assessment (CSA), which uses a consistent, rules-based methodology to convert an average of 600 data points per company into one overall score.
